**1 - FOUR-LEAF CLOVER** The most recognized good luck charm in the world, each leaf carries a meaning: hope, faith, love, and luck. It also symbolizes the circle of life and the four elements (earth, air, fire, water). Since ancient times, it was believed that carrying one could help see spirits and avoid danger.

**2 - HORSESHOE** A charm considered lucky in many cultures, especially Anglo-Saxon ones. Since the Middle Ages, it was believed to be a powerful shield against epidemics and the Devil. It is said to bring good luck, especially if hung above a door with the ends pointing upward to keep the luck from "slipping away."

**3 - HORN** Also known as the "cornicello," it is a traditional Italian charm. Considered a symbol of virility, physical strength, and fertility since the Neolithic era. Its shape is inspired by Priapus' phallus, the god of fertility, and its red color represents the power of blood and fire.

**4 - LADYBUG** In many traditions, the ladybug is seen as a bearer of good fortune and prosperity. It is also associated with love and happiness, particularly in relation to weddings and new beginnings. Since ancient times connected to the goddess Juno and later to the Virgin Mary, it emits protective energy against danger.

**5 - HORNED HAND** The gesture of making "horns" with the hand facing downward is itself an amulet to ward off misfortune and the evil eye. Its origins are uncertain, but some theories trace it back to ancient Greece and the myth of the Minotaur, associated with shamanic practices.

**6 - EGYPTIAN SCARAB** A powerful symbol in ancient Egypt, the scarab was associated with the morning manifestation of the sun god Ra. Egyptians believed it pushed the sun into the sky each day, symbolizing the cycle of life, death, and rebirth.

**7 - HAMSÁ HAND (Hand of Fatima)** In Islam and Judaism, this is a protective amulet against the evil eye and negative influences, associated with strength, power, and blessings. The five fingers represent the five pillars of Islam, the five books of the Torah, and the connection between body and soul. The eye in the center is considered the eye of God watching over the wearer.

**8 - NAZAR** Common in Turkey, Greece, and the Middle East, the word "Nazar" in Arabic means "gaze." Its shape resembles the Eye of Allah (or Greek eye), which protects the bearer from envy and the evil eye with its loving watchfulness. If the Nazar breaks, don't worry: it means it has protected you!

**9 - MANEKI NEKO** A Japanese figurine of a cat raising its paw in a welcoming gesture typical of Japanese culture. It attracts luck, prosperity, customers, and good fortune—especially used in shops and businesses. Depending on whether it raises the right or left paw, it attracts either wealth or clients. The white Maneki Neko brings general happiness and good luck.

**10 - ACORN** Traditional in Northern Europe, especially in Germanic cultures, it is considered sacred to Thor, god of thunder and protection. In the past, it was believed wearing

an acorn could protect against disease, aging, and even alcoholism. Today, it is a symbol of health and prosperity, especially if placed on a windowsill at home.

**11 - ELEPHANT** In Eastern cultures, an elephant with its trunk raised is believed to bring good luck, wealth, and prosperity. In Hindu culture, the elephant symbolizes wisdom, strength, and home protection.

**12 - DALA HORSE** Refers to the "Dalahäst," a traditional painted wooden horse from the Swedish province of Dalarna. Originally crafted as a children's toy by 18th-century woodcutters, it is now associated with good luck, friendship, energy, strength, and problem-solving.

**13 - LILY OF THE VALLEY** In France, gifting a sprig of lily of the valley on May 1st, Labor Day, is a wish for good luck and happiness. This lucky tradition was introduced by King Charles IX in the 16th century.

**14 - COIN TALISMAN** In China, coins are powerful amulets symbolizing prosperity. Often tied together with red thread (a symbol of life energy, protection, and activation of luck), pink stone coins represent love, peace, and emotional healing.

**15 - BLACK OBSIDIAN PYRAMID** A natural volcanic glass with an intense black color and shine, it is considered the stone of transformation. A powerful tool for self-discovery, it helps overcome fears and traumas while serving as a protective shield. It promotes grounding, wisdom, and clarity of purpose, aiding in important decision-making.

**16 - CLEAR QUARTZ** In many cultures, it is considered a stone of light, purity, harmony, and balance. Associated with truth and clarity, it symbolizes both physical and spiritual balance. It enhances concentration, is believed to boost self-confidence and intuition, and helps release energetic blockages.

**17 - MIRRORS** Seen as magical objects, they are believed to influence the energy of a space by protecting the home and repelling negative energies and evil spirits. According to Feng Shui, mirrors can amplify positive energy and attract abundance.

**18 - YES-NO COIN** A coin that, when tossed, helps make decisions between two options: "Yes" or "No." Use it for quick decision-making or to add a touch of luck to your choices.

**19 - LUCKY CARD** A true 2D concentration of good fortune that you can always carry with you or place over your heart during your rituals and lucky charms practices.

**DARK BLUE and GOLD** In many cultures, dark blue is considered a protective and spiritual color. Gold has the power to attract positive energy related to wealth and good luck.


